Qualification

This entrance examination is intended for both International and Japanese nationals for whom Japanese is not their first language. All applicants must book an interview to verify eligibility prior to official application. Interviews can be booked anytime from Nov 20th 2017 to Jan 24th 2018, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.

Entrance Examination Fee

- ① **Completed application form** (with 2 photos and proof of money transfer) **1p**
 - ② **Student record or school transcript issued by a junior high school** **1p**
(There is no standard transcript format required.)
 - ③ **Certificate of graduation or proof of anticipated graduation from a junior high school** (for overseas applicants) **1p**
- *All applicants must be pre-interviewed to verify qualifications

Screening Process

- **Written Tests** : English
: Mathematics
 - *Applicants may take the Mathematics test with instructions in the following languages:
English, Chinese, Russian, Korean, Thai, Indonesian and Vietnamese.
 - **Review of student record or school transcript**
 - **Applicant Interview accompanied by a guardian**
- All application materials and information will be reviewed thoroughly.
